Technical Category: This category is intended for students pursuing a program for an A&P Mechanic Certificate, Aircraft Maintenance Technician, Aircraft Maintenance Management, Aircraft Dispatcher Certificate, Flight Operations or Dispatch Professional, or other similar pursuits.

Scholarship checks are sent to the schools by mid-May and are to be used for tuition and lab fees for that upcoming school year. It is the intent of the organizations to award up to two \$1,000 scholarships for students pursuing degrees in support of a professional or technical aviation career.

These \$1,000 minimum scholarships are not based on an endowment and sometimes are not awarded.
